

DPW – PARKS Tree Work Permit Information

A Tree Work Permit is required to plant, prune or remove trees within City of Buffalo right of way. There is no fee to obtain a permit.

Please provide the following information to the Division of Parks and Recreation at least **30 days** before you plan to perform work on city trees:

- resident contact information
- expected date of tree work
- proposed location(s), species and caliper (for tree planting)
- landscape contractor contact information expected to perform the work (must include City of Buffalo license number)
- name of organization for volunteer community plantings
