Instructions for a Chief Stationary Engineer

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

An applicant for a Chief Class Stationary Engineer shall be an engineer who is found competent to take charge of any power plant of any horsepower and pressure. Each applicant for a Chief Stationary Engineer license must pass a written and practical examination as to his/her qualifications. Each applicant needs to prove to the Chief Examiner of Stationary Engineers that he/she has had three (3) years actual experience as a duly licensed First Class Stationary Engineer. Merely having a First Class Stationary Engineer license for three years does not qualify an individual for a Chief Class Stationary Engineer's examination.
