## LANDLORD INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE LEAD PAINT NOTICE FORM AND ATTESTATION

- 1. Compliance with the <u>Lead Paint Notice Form</u> and Lead Paint Notice Form Attestation is required by Local Law. Failure to comply may results in fines, revocation of rental registration and other penalties as provided by law.
- 2. If you own more than one property subject to the Rental Registration Fee, fill out an Attestation for each property.
- 3. The <u>Lead Paint Notice Form</u> should be delivered to the named leaseholder(s) of the property. If you do not have a lease, the form should be delivered to all adult tenants occupying the property. Adult tenants are individuals whom you believe to be over the age of 18.
- 4. If, to the best of your knowledge, the leaseholder does not live in the rental unit, the form should be delivered to all adult tenants.
- Acceptable methods of delivery of the <u>Lead Paint Notice Form</u> and are as follows:
  - a. Personal delivery to tenant(s); OR
  - b. Delivery by a property manager or agent for the property to tenant(s);
    OR
  - c. Certified mail addressed to the leaseholder if the leaseholder resides in the property. Maintain proof of the mailing provided by the Post Office. If the mail is undeliverable or the leaseholder does not live in the property, delivery to tenants over 18 is required.
- 6. Both the landlord/managing agent and tenant must sign and date the form. If the landlord has retained a property manager for the property, the property manager or agent by sign on behalf of the Landlord.
- 7. A witness must sign that he or she witnessed the tenant sign the <u>Lead Paint Notice Form</u>.
- 8. Execute two copies of the form. The tenant should keep one copy and the landlord should keep another copy.
- 9. Keep a copy of the disclosure form for your records. You may be asked to produce the form in the future.
- 10. If you are renovating more than 6 square feet of interior space or 20 square feet of exterior space, you must deliver the <u>HUD/EPA Renovation Pamphlet</u> at least 7 days prior to the renovation. Delivery may be provided in the same manner as the Lead Paint Notice Form.
- 11. If you or an agent are delivering the HUD/EPA Pamphlet, sign the brochure on the back of the brochure and request that the tenant also sign and maintain the form. The signature page for the HUD/EPA Pamphlet for renovations is at the back of the pamphlet.
